- First Indian Diaspora Convention in Zimbabwe was organized by the Embassy of India and Indian community in Zimbabwe in 2019.



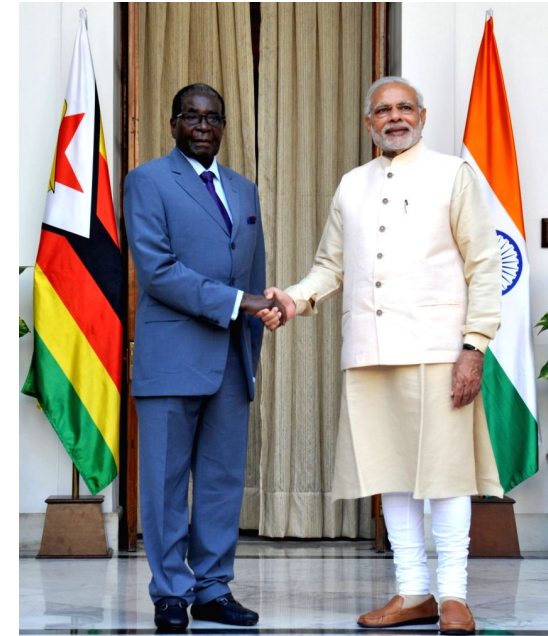

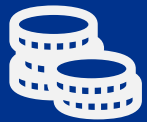

## Trade and Investment Relations:-

- Indian public sector companies in Zimbabwe include Water and Power Consultancy Services and Telecommunications India Ltd.
- Kirloskar and Jain Irrigation have supplied pumps and irrigation equipment. Ranbaxy and Ipca Labs are present in health sector.
- An Indian pharmaceutical company, "Shreya" had invested about US\$ 1 million in- 'CAPS Ltd' – largest pharma company in Zimbabwe.
- Investments by a few other Indian companies in Zimbabwe are: Surface Investment, ZimGold, the edible oil company etc.
